



## What size paper is best for you?

Student: Write your name on each of the four lines. Pay attention to which lines "feel best" to you and are the most comfortable for you to write on.

Teachers & Parents: If the child doesn't know which lines feel "right", look at the height of his/her tall letters and short letters. The tall letters are important, but I find that it works well to choose the line that best fits the size of the student's short letters. The short letters should fit comfortably within the shaded area without too much extra space. Children understand easily when you tell them to make the short letters stay inside the shaded area.
